Spring League Participant Parents, Coaches and Officials,

Thank you for choosing Conway Arena as your spring hockey home. The goal of Conway Arena youth league is to allow kids to continue playing hockey, gain additional skill and ice time. The league is not intended to be an overly competitive one, but a recreational league. The # 1 priority of the league is to ensure that there is parity between teams. To achieve this goal it may be necessary to move players/teams around in the first 2 weeks.

All Divisions will play three 12 minute periods

Guidelines

1. Penalties will be assessed in the following manner:

When a player is issued a penalty they will serve the minor penalty time (1 minute for mites/squirts and 1.5 minutes for peewees).

The team receiving the penalty will remain with 3 players with the other team adding a fourth skater for the power-play. At the end of the penalty, the penalized player will leave the box and can immediately enter play. The teams will remain at 4 on 4 until the next whistle at which play will return to 3 on 3.

2. There will be no REDLINE in the 3 on 3 league. Thus meaning that icing will be whistled when the puck is iced from inside the blue line

3. In the event a team is down by 6 goals,

- An additional skater (4 on 3) on the ice until they close the gap to 3 goals. The clock will be stop time with the exception of the 3rd period when there is a 6+ score. The clock will remain running time until the gap is cut to 3 goals, at which time play will return to stop time.
- If the team with 4 players receives a penalty they will play with only 3 players for the duration of the penalty. The team that has the 6+ goal lead will not be allowed to add a player for the penalty; the teams will play 3 on 3 for the duration of the penalty. Once a penalty expires the player coming for the box may immediately enter play.
- If the team with 3 players receives a penalty, the other team will be able to add a 5th player thus creating a 5 on 3 for the duration of the penalty. Once the penalty expires the penalized player may immediately enter play, making it 5 on 4 until the next whistle, at which time play will return to 3 on 3
- **HAT TRICK PARITY PROVISION RULE**
NO player to score more than 3 goals, must pass or goals won't count.

In the event of a tie in standings in all divisions, the tie breaker is as follows:

- A. Head to head competition
- B. Goals against
- C. Penalty minutes

In the event three teams are tied, head to head is not counted and goals against will be the first tie breaker.
